Sea-level rise and more frequent and destructive storms are already impacting the Eastern Seaboard, causing major damage to communities, infrastructure, and even our adaptive, protective marshlands, like those of Plum Island on the North Shore of Massachusetts. With support from NASA, Professor Sergio Fagherazzi and his team of Boston University researchers are measuring the resilience of these areas.
