As you may know, the Boston University Graduate Workers Union (BUGWU) <u>voted on October</u> <u>16</u> to ratify the University's <u>three-year contract offer</u> and end their strike.

You are receiving this email because you currently hold or have held a service-paid research or teaching position represented by BUGWU.

During the strike period, graduate students in salaried service positions were asked to complete a weekly attestation survey certifying their work effort so the University could pay those who chose to work during the strike. Now that the strike has ended, it is no longer necessary to submit these weekly attestations.

If there are any attestations you may have missed for previous payroll periods, we ask that you please use the Qualtrics link shared below to attest to your work effort. This link will remain continuously open through Friday, November 15, with Kerberos authentication required.
