

Minor in Education Program Sheet

The Education minor is offered to undergraduate students at Boston University wishing to enhance their knowledge of education. Requirements include **15 credits of core courses and 8 credits of electives**. A grade of **C or higher** must be attained in all classes applied toward the minor. Only two classes can be counted toward a major and a minor. No more than two classes may be taken at an external institution and applied to a Wheelock minor.
